## **Notification of Work Restrictions**

It has been reported by a medical doctor that you have the infectious disease indicated below. To prevent the spread of the disease, you are hereby notified of the work restrictions indicated below, according to the regulations of the Law on the Prevention of Infectious Diseases and the Treatment of Patients, Article 18 Section 2

1. If you have a complaint about the content of this notification, you can contact the Mayor to request an examination within three months of the day after you are informed of this decision.

<sup>2.</sup> In addition to the request for an examination stated in 1 above, you can file an appeal for cancellation of this decision against Kanazawa City (represented by the Mayor) within six months of the day after you are informed of the decision. If you have submitted the request for an examination stated in 1 above, you can file an appeal for cancellation within six months of the day after you are informed of the decision on your request for an examination.

<sup>3.</sup> Notwithstanding the above, you cannot request an examination or file an appeal for cancellation if one year has passed starting from the day after this decision (or the decision on your request for an examination). However, if there is good reason, you may request an examination or appeal for cancellation of the decision after the periods stated above, or even after one year has passed starting from the day after this decision (or the decision on your request for an examination).
